

Biblical Feasts Dates 2025

(1) FEAST OF PASSOVER (PESACH)

Starts on April 12 at sundown and ends at sundown on April 13, 2025

“On the fourteenth day of the first month at twilight is the LORD’s Passover.” (Leviticus 23:5, NKJV)

(2) FEAST OF UNLEAVENED BREAD (CHAG HAMATZOT)

Starts on April 13 at sundown and ends at sundown on April 20, 2025

“And on the fifteenth day of the same month is the Feast of Unleavened Bread to the LORD; seven days you must eat unleavened bread. On the first day you shall have a holy convocation; you shall do no customary work on it. But you shall offer an offering made by fire to the LORD for seven days. The seventh day shall be a holy convocation; you shall do no customary work on it.” (Leviticus 23:6–8, NKJV)

(3) FEAST OF FIRSTFRUITS/RESURRECTION (YOM HABIKKURIM)

Starts on April 19 at sundown and ends at sundown on April 20, 2025

“Speak to the children of Israel, and say to them: ‘When you come into the land which I give to you, and reap its harvest, then you shall bring a sheaf of the firstfruits of your harvest to the priest. He shall wave the sheaf before the LORD, to be accepted on your behalf; on the day after the Sabbath the priest shall wave it.’” (Leviticus 23:10–11, NKJV)

Note: Judaism observes Firstfruits on the day after the High Sabbath of the Feast. But according to our understanding of Scripture and with clear guidance from the Gospels, we observe it on the day after the weekly Sabbath, which will change from year to year, but make Firstfruits always fall on the first day of the week (Saturday evening to Sunday evening). The Counting of the Omer begins on this day. For more information, see “Additional Dates.”

(4) FEAST OF PENTECOST (SHAVUOT)

Starts on June 7 at sundown and ends at sundown on June 8, 2025

“And you shall count for yourselves from the day after the Sabbath, from the day that you brought the sheaf of the wave offering: seven Sabbaths shall be completed. Count fifty days to the day after the seventh Sabbath; then you shall offer a new grain offering to the LORD.” (Leviticus 23:15–16, NKJV)

Note: Pentecost is 50 inclusive days from Firstfruits. Since we observe Firstfruits on the day after the weekly Sabbath, the count will always conclude on the first day of the week (Saturday evening to Sunday evening), even though the date may vary from year to year.

(5) FEAST OF TRUMPETS (ROSH HASHANAH/YOM TERUAH)

Starts on September 22 at sundown and ends at sundown on September 23, 2025

“Speak to the children of Israel, saying: ‘In the seventh month, on the first day of the month, you shall have a sabbath-rest, a memorial of blowing of trumpets, a holy convocation. You shall do no customary work on it; and you shall offer an offering made by fire to the LORD.’” (Leviticus 23:24–25, NKJV)

(6) DAY OF ATONEMENT – CONGREGATIONAL FAST (YOM KIPPUR)

Starts on October 1 at sundown and ends at sundown on October 2, 2025

“Also the tenth day of this seventh month shall be the Day of Atonement. It shall be a holy convocation for you; you shall afflict your souls, and offer an offering made by fire to the LORD. And you shall do no work on that same day, for it is the Day of Atonement, to make atonement for you before the LORD your God.” (Leviticus 23:27–28, NKJV)

Note: The Forty Days of Repentance are foreshadowed by the temptation of our Lord in the wilderness. These forty days from Elul 1 lead to the Day of Atonement, a day of national repentance. The last ten days, from the Feast of Trumpets to the Day of Atonement, are known as the Days of Awe. For more info, see “Additional Dates.”

(7) FEAST OF TABERNACLES & THE EIGHTH DAY: THE LAST GREAT DAY (SUKKOT/HOSHANA RABBAH)

Starts on October 6 at sundown and ends at sundown on October 14, 2025

“For seven days you shall offer an offering made by fire to the LORD. On the eighth day you shall have a holy convocation, and you shall offer an offering made by fire to the LORD. It is a sacred assembly, and you shall do no customary work on it. ‘These are the feasts of the LORD which you shall proclaim to be holy convocations, to offer an offering made by fire to the LORD, a burnt offering and a grain offering, a sacrifice and drink offerings, everything on its day—‘besides the Sabbaths of the LORD, besides your gifts, besides all your vows, and besides all your freewill offerings which you give to the LORD.’” (Leviticus 23:36–38, NKJV)

March 13 at sundown and ends at sundown on March 14, 2025

BIBLICAL NEW YEAR (THE SPRINGTIME NEW YEAR)

March 30 at sundown and ends at sundown on March 31, 2025

COUNTING OF THE OMER (50 DAYS TO PENTECOST)

April 20 at sundown and ends at sundown on June 7, 2025

SECOND PASSOVER (SECOND CHANCE FOR PASSOVER)

May 12 at sundown and ends at sundown on May 13, 2025

THE 9TH OF AV (DESTRUCTION OF THE TEMPLE)

August 2 at sundown and ends at sundown on August 3, 2025

FORTY DAYS OF REPENTANCE (LEADING UP TO THE DAY OF ATONEMENT)

August 23 at sundown and ends at sundown on October 2, 2025

DAYS OF AWE - 10 DAYS (FROM THE FEAST OF TRUMPETS TO THE DAY OF ATONEMENT)

September 22 at sundown and ends at sundown on October 2, 2025

HANUKKAH (FESTIVAL OF DEDICATION)

December 14 at sundown and ends at sundown on December 22, 2025

Annual Festive Sabbaths:

FIRST DAY OF THE FEAST OF UNLEAVENED BREAD

April 13 at sundown and ends at sundown on April 14, 2025

LAST DAY OF THE FEAST OF UNLEAVENED BREAD

April 19 at sundown and ends at sundown on April 20, 2025

FEAST OF PENTECOST

June 7 at sundown and ends at sundown on June 8, 2025

FEAST OF TRUMPETS

September 22 at sundown and ends at sundown on September 23, 2025

DAY OF ATONEMENT (SPECIAL FAST)

October 1 at sundown and ends at sundown on October 2, 2025

FIRST DAY OF THE FEAST OF TABERNACLES

October 6 at sundown and ends at sundown on October 7, 2025

EIGHTH DAY OF THE FEAST OF TABERNACLES

October 13 at sundown and ends at sundown on October 14, 2025
